ABOUT THE EXHIBITION – WHY VISIT APT6?

APT6 will occupy the entire Gallery of Modern Art (GoMA) building, as well as the Watermill and adjoining galleries at the Queensland Art Gallery (QAG). It will include the work of more than 100 artists from 25 countries, including collaborations and collectives, reflecting the diversity of practices across Asia, the Pacific and Australia.

APT6 will have a number of specific focuses and thematic links, and will feature artists from communities that have not been represented in the APT before, such as Tibet, North Korea (DPRK), Turkey and Iran, and from countries of the Mekong region such as Cambodia and Myanmar (Burma).

APT6 and Kids' APT will engage students of all levels.

A PowerPoint featuring images and video interviews of artists involved in Kids' APT.

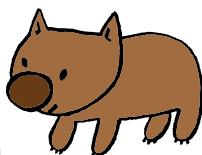
